Properties:

NACASA is a natural universal cleaning agent for gentle and mild cleaning of oiled, waxed, glazed, and varnished finishes on floors, window frames, doors, tiles, wood, plastics, etc. It is particularly skin-friendly and biodegradable. No chemical preservatives, free of chlorine, ammonium chloride, and phosphate.

Ingredients:

Water, < 5 % anionic and amphoteric tenside from coconut fat, citral, silver sulphate, chlorophyll.



Application:

Add 1/2 cap from the 1 liter bottle or 10 ml to 1 liter of cleaning water. For extreme dirt buildup use as-is only in specific locations. Do not overdose since this may otherwise result in streaks.

Substrates generally only need to be wiped to a moist film. Clean dry first as needed. A compressed air atomizer is best for moist film cleaning on floors treated with BIOFA products. It is used to simply apply diluted NACASA on the floor or a mop or rag; then wipe the surface. Then wipe dry.

Following moist film cleaning, tile surfaces are also wiped dry as needed.

Wipe all other surfaces only to a moist film and allow to dry. For tough dirt stains, apply NACASA Universal Cleaner as-is on a rag or sponge; then treat stained areas separately. Then rinse with plenty of clear warm water.
